

BOX ELDER SWIM TEAM BEHAVIORAL STANDARDS

BEST TEAM BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

Best swimmers responsibilities to themselves, teammates, and coaches are the following:

- Be prompt and prepared to swim.
- Follow directions.
- Be supportive of teammates
- Set a good example at home meets and away meets.

The following behaviors will NOT be tolerated:

- Foul language/ swearing.
- Sexually explicit language.
- Sexual innuendos.
- Name-calling.
- Inappropriate touching of another swimmer.
- Harassment of another swimmer and/ or coach.
- Failure to follow the coach's directions.
- Horseplay either in the water or in the locker rooms.
- Disturbing someone else's belongings. (Backpacks, lockers, clothing. Hiding other peoples' belongings. Borrowing someone else's belongings without their consent.)

Any exhibition of these behaviors will result in the following consequences:

- First Offense:** A verbal warning and a phone call home from the coach.
- Second Offense:** Letter from coach sent home with swimmer. A copy of the same letter sent to the Board Members and a follow-up phone call to the parents.
- Third Offense: IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE TEAM**

All swimmers have the right to practice and compete in a safe environment, free from harassment and without threat of verbal or physical abuse.

Coaches are paid to be instructors and monitor the safety of the swimmer. They are not paid to be babysitters or locker room monitors. Coaches have the right to coach free from disruption and harassment.
